



Historical Voice Paper

The *Historical Voice* paper is where your creative mind is blended with your researching mind. The emphasis is on trying to recreate an event, or bring a historical figure alive.

Format: This is the only *informal* style of the *7-Key Forms of Writing Assessment* in a history course, meaning that you will often use 1st and 2nd person (“I” “You” “We”). The format will vary widely from letters to journals/ debates/ artwork...Therefore, the required format will be specific to each *Historical Voice* assessment.

Content: You will begin with researching your particular historical role, character, event, battle, debate... Then you will write/draw/paint/ build/argue/report in that assigned *Historical Voice*. Having actual quotations, genuine reflections, and further insights are your tools to bring the history alive.
